### Patent and Trademark Prosecution Services & Fees

USPTO Utility Provisional Patent Application (UPPA): Draft and file your application with the USPTO, including Spec, Abstract, Drawings (≤4 CAD sheets drafted at Firm's expense), Summary, Detailed Description, Oath, POA, ADS, IDS, Transmittal, Entity Certification and all necessary follow-up with USPTO. While a UPPA gives applicant "Patent Pending" status, a UPPA expires within 12 months if not followed with a Non-provisional Application. [\$3,450 Simple Mechanical Apparatus Device or Method/Process – 8.5K Software/Computer-Implemented Invention / Network Functionality Utility Provisional Application].

USPTO Non-provisional Utility Patent Application (NPA): Draft and file your application with the USPTO, including a Specification covering embodiments and best mode of your invention, Drawings (≤4 CAD sheets drafted at Firm's expense), and Claims which distinctly and broadly cover the subject matter of your invention. The NPA includes preparation and filing of an information data sheet with prior art references, your inventor's oath, application data sheet, transmittal form, small or micro entity certification form if applicable, power of attorney form and fee calculation sheet. [\$7.25K Simple Mechanical, Method/Process -18K Software/Computer-Implemented Invention/Network Functionality; UPPA Fee credited if drafted and filed by Foundation Patents].

USPTO Non-Provisional Design Patent Application (DPA): Draft and file application with the USPTO, including Spec, MPEP-acceptable design drawings (8 views, including exploded, perspective, and all required views), and all required USPTO forms and Claim(s) through to Allowance and Publication. [\$3,250 if initial drawings are workable models, add \$145 per sheet to render and draw Figures (design patent drawings) from solely idea/prototype/instructions.

PCT International Patent Application: Draft and file your PCT RO 101 Request Form, Specification, Claims and Drawings, and then file your application with the U.S. Receiving Office of the PCT or IB in Geneva. Draft and file all associated documents needed for PCT filing, including Small or Micro certification form if applicable. The PCT "reserves your spot" in all of its 148 countries for 18 months while you determine which countries in which to enter the national stage. During these 18 months, you receive an International Search Report and Written Opinion of the International Searching Authority, as well as International Publication. [\$8K Simple Mechanical, Method/Process – 18K Software/Network Functionality/Computer-Implemented Invention(s); Fees do not include Entry into National Stage or Article XIX Amendments].

Patentability Search and Opinion: Comprehensive search of all published patents and applications in the field of your invention. A detailed report gives a formal opinion and recommendation on the patentability of your invention, distinguishing your invention from prior art references in your field and predicting USPTO Examiners' decisions on novelty and obviousness. [\$5,400 Simple Mechanical, Method/Process – 9K Software/Network Functionality].

Trademark Search and Opinion: Comprehensive search and review of the USPTO TESS database in all relevant Word and Design Mark fields, as well as relevant references we discuss in your field. The Report will give a legal opinion as to international class, use and specimen in commerce, distinctiveness, ornamentation, and likelihood of confusion with similar marks. [\$475 USPTO TESS Database Search and Report, \$875 Comprehensive Database Search and Report].

Trademark Filing: Prepare and file your trademark application with the USPTO. Collect and prepare all relevant word and design mark information and specimens necessary to complete the application for filing with the USPTO, determine international class and description, electronically file Application for Registration with the USPTO [\$1675 per International Class Preparation Filing, plus \$250 USPTO Filing eFile Discounted Rate, per International Class]. Search included; Registration (success) guaranteed or Firm pays for follow-up application.

Fees: Additional post-disclosure embodiments= \$500- \$1,500 each  
Drawings >4 (above 4 included in contract)= \$65- \$135 each for Utility Patents, \$145- \$190 each for Design Patents
